



## **LES PERRY MEMORIAL GRANT PROGRAM**

### **INFORMATION AND CRITERIA 2021**

#### **PREAMBLE**

The grant program has been instigated to recognise the substantial contribution made to SRWRA by the late Les Perry. Les Perry was the Executive Officer of SRWRA from 1999 to 2007 and his dedicated and tireless efforts are acknowledged in the waste management industry.

#### **PURPOSE**

The grant aims to support projects and activities that contribute to the education of primary school students in the area of waste minimisation and recycling.

The purpose of the grant is to assist in the development of a school or individual class project that encourages student participation and offers innovative approaches to recycle or re-use materials and resources sustainably.

#### **AVAILABLE FUNDING**

A maximum amount of \$750 (ex GST) per school is available for one project.

There is no minimum application amount.

#### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?**

- Any Primary School located in the Onkaparinga, Marion and Holdfast Bay Council areas.

#### **ESSENTIAL CRITERIA**

The application:

- must have a clearly stated purpose and a clear plan for achieving this purpose
- must comply with recognised Australian Standards and must observe any relevant Federal, State or Local Government regulations or guidelines
- all projects must relate to the purpose of the grant
- all projects must achieve waste minimisation or recycling outcomes

#### **WHAT PRIORITIES DETERMINE THE ALLOCATION OF GRANTS?**

Given the limited availability of funds, priority will be given to projects that:

- satisfy the essential criteria
- demonstrate significant benefit to the student's education
- indicate an innovative approach to recycle or re-use materials and resources sustainably

## **HOW IS AN APPLICATION MADE?**

Applications using the Grant Application Form will be accepted up until close of business on 30 March 2021. **Applications postmarked after this deadline will not be accepted.**

## **ASSESSMENT PROCESS AND TIMEFRAME**

Once an application has been received:

- it will be acknowledged by SRWRA
- a panel, convened by SRWRA will assess the applications
- the panel will determine which applications will be funded and to what amount
- SRWRA will advise all applicants by 30 April 2021 of the outcome.

## **THE TAX SYSTEM**

Applicants should be aware of the Federal Government's Taxation requirements, including the GST and the Australian Business Number (ABN). These may have implications for your projects.

## **CONDITIONS OF FUNDING**

The successful applicant will be required to sign the conditions of funding and agree that:

- the funds provided must be used solely for the approved project
- any changes to the project that would result in funding being expended for activities other than those detailed in the application may not be undertaken without prior written approval of SRWRA
- at the conclusion of the project a written evaluation including an expenditure statement must be provided to SRWRA
- it is required that successful applicants will comply with this condition within 12 months of receipt of the grant
